

The Village Hall Trust

The Village Hall is a Charitable Trust which is run by a committee and overseen by Trustees all of whom are volunteers.

The running costs which include insurance, heating, lighting, rates and cleaning are covered by the revenue received from letting the hall.

For those of you who are interested in becoming a trustee, let us know as well. Managing the Hall is a team effort, and new people not only reinforce the group, but also bring new passion and skills.



Booking Costs

Private functions for those living in the parish
£10 an hour

Private functions for those living outside the parish
£15 an hour

Commercial bookings when hirer makes a profit
£18 an hour

Renters must accept the rules of hire along with their booking confirmation.

Parking

Adjacent to the hall is a private car park, The public village green car park is also just across the lane.

Lighting

Lighting is by fluorescent tubes, but we also have dimmable LED lighting.

Furniture

There are 96 red plastic seated chairs, 20 padded seated chairs and 3 wooden chairs.

There are 10 Gopak folding tables 1800mm long and 8 which are 900mm long plus 6 steel folding tables 600mm in diameter.

The use of these are included in the hall rental but there additional fees may apply when used outside (e.g. £6 per table & 50p per chair)

Kitchen & Accessories

The kitchen meets local regulations with 2 kettles, electric hob/oven, fridge, small freezer, microwave, with an urn for hot water.

There is a comprehensive collection of cutlery, plates cups and saucers, glasses, saucepans plus numerous other items.



Central to the village with parking & amenities

Facilities

In addition to separate ladies and gents toilets, there is a disabled toilet/baby change room. Both ladies and gents have family toilet seats.

There is a gas combi-boiler that provides the central heating and hot water.

Sound & Vision

There are two AV projectors with the main one mounted on a cross beam that can project onto a large screen which has an electric motor to open and retract it.

The other projector is mounted on a cross beam in front of the stage and projects to a roll down screen on the back wall.

There is coiled VGA cable halfway down the hall to connect to the main projector plus an HDMI cable in a small blue cupboard by the hi-fi unit.

The blue cupboard also has a VGA cable to connect to the projector in front of the stage.

There is an amplifier with a number of speakers plus hearing loop which can be used with DVD's or music plus a microphone.

Stage

There is a 3.1 metre deep stage at the end of the hall which can be reduced in length, if necessary.
